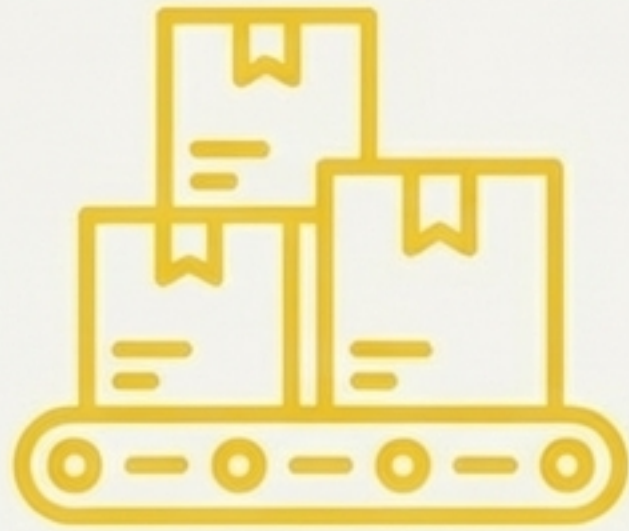

Key Employers: Cafes, bars, event venues, Christmas markets.

Often involves day and night shifts, offering more flexibility.

Your Application Game Plan



Hunt Smart

Use broad job boards like SEEK and Indeed (search 'Christmas casual [your city]'), but also go directly to retailer career pages (e.g., myer.com.au/careers). Don't forget Gumtree and Facebook jobs groups.



Tailor Your Resume

What to Highlight: Customer service skills, a positive and energetic attitude, and—most importantly—your complete availability for December and January.



Ace the Interview

What They're Looking For: Energy, friendliness, and flexibility. Show you're ready for a fast-paced environment.



Check Your Visa

A Note for International Applicants: Ensure your visa gives you valid work rights for the duration of the role.

Your Availability is Your Superpower.

Employers will always prioritize candidates who are completely free during peak trading periods. Clearly state your availability for late nights, weekends, Boxing Day, and New Year's to put your application at the top of the pile.

Spotlight: The Boxing Day Gold Rush

How to earn \$300 - \$500+ in a single day.

Short, intense shifts for a massive cash boost.

****Pro-Tip to Stand Out**:** Explicitly mention your availability for Boxing Day (and Dec 27) in your resume and interview. It's what hiring managers are looking for.

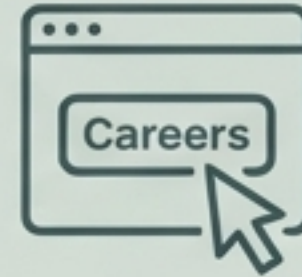

Insider Tips to Get Ahead of the Crowd



Go Old School: Walk In.

Don't just apply online. Walk into stores with your printed resume. Many managers still hire enthusiastic candidates on the spot.



Go Direct: Use Company Websites.

Applying directly via a retailer's career page often gets you better visibility and faster processing than using a general job board.



Be Vocal: Emphasize Energy.

Retailers hire for attitude. Emphasize your people skills, energy, and enthusiasm in your application and interview.



Be Open: Flexibility = More Shifts.

The more available you are, the more hours you'll be offered. Say yes to a wide range of shifts to become a go-to employee.

Understanding Your Pay



Base Rate: Varies by award (e.g., General Retail Industry Award).



Public Holiday Rate: Often 225-250% of your base pay.

Your Christmas Job Success Checklist



Polish Your Resume: Highlight customer service skills, energy, and enthusiasm.

Focus on demonstrating soft skills and relevant experience for the busy holiday period.



Map Out Target Employers: Focus on direct company career pages for the best results.

Avoid generic job boards where applications might get lost. Check retailer websites frequently.



Define Your Superpower: Clearly identify and state your availability for all peak periods, especially late nights, weekends, and Boxing Day.

Being upfront about maximum flexibility for key shifts increases your hireability.



Apply Early, Apply Often: Start your applications now. The best roles are filled between August and October.

Don't wait for the last minute; early applicants have a significant advantage.
